# PACIFIC UNION EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP POLICY

## I

### IMPELLING DIRECTIVE

*“It should be made a part of gospel labor to help forward promising young men who give evidence that the love of truth and righteousness has a constraining influence upon them, leading them to dedicate themselves to the work of God, as medical missionaries, as canvassers, as evangelists. Let a fund be established to carry this work forward. Then, let those who have received help go forth to minister to the sick and suffering. This work will surely open the way for the balm of Gilead to be applied to sin-sick souls.”* (Ellen G. White, Selected Messages, Book 2, pages 208, 209.)

## II

### PURPOSE

In an effort to find, challenge, and prepare potential, dynamic lay or employed leaders for the Seventh-day Adventist Church, the Pacific Union Conference Education Scholarships purpose is to give scholarships to worthy students enrolled in a Seventh-day Adventist school, or college in the Pacific Union Conference who meet the following qualifications.

## III

### QUALIFICATIONS

The following are standards to be met by the prospective student in order to qualify for a PACIFIC UNION CONFERENCE EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP:

- Is a member of a Seventh-day Adventist Church within the Pacific Union, an unbaptized child of an Adventist parent, or a student who is being sponsored by a Seventh-day Adventist.
- Will be enrolled as a full-time student in a Seventh-day Adventist elementary school, junior academy, senior academy, or in an undergraduate program (including the fifth-year teacher education program) in La Sierra University, Loma Linda University, Montemorelos University, Oakwood College, or Pacific Union College.
- Meets the acceptable scholarships and citizenship requirements of the school or college and authorizes a review of these records by the appropriate authorized persons.
- Will make a special commitment to spiritual excellence by the local conference’s accepted norm.
- Does not receive tuition assistance for children of denominational employees.
- Completes and signs Part A of the application form and includes the required attachments.
- Is nominated by the Office of Education in the Conference where the applicant lives.

## IV

### STUDENT RECIPIENTS TO BE NOMINATED, SPONSORED, AND APPROVED

An individual, local church, or school may recommend a student for nomination. Scholarships will be issued to students who are sponsored by the nominating conference and who have been approved by the Pacific Union Conference Office of Education.

For each student nominated by the conference, an application form must be completed, fully signed, dated, and mailed to the Pacific Union Conference sufficiently in advance of the award date.

## V

### GRANT FUNDS ARE FOR THE BENEFIT OF QUALIFYING STUDENTS REGARDLESS OF RACE, COLOR, SEX OR NATIONAL ORIGIN.

## HELPFUL HINTS FOR COMPLETING THE EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Did you remember to:

- Answer questions #1-13.
- Attach all three pages to answer #14. (Please type & include name on each attachment.)
  1. **School Activities Description:** A parent can write down what the child says, if the child is very young. If the child is just starting school, have them tell what they like to do, as they do not yet have school activities.
  2. **Letter of Recommendation:** A letter of recommendation from a pastor or teacher must be ATTACHED. A few lines written in Part B does NOT fulfill this requirement.
  3. **Statement of Dedication:** Tell why you want to serve the Lord, and dedicate yourself to Him, not why you like your school. This plays a big part in the decision as to who will receive a scholarship. (Note: Your answer to this question may be used for marketing, reports for board meetings, sermons, etc., unless you let us know in writing that you do not give your permission. Your name will not be used.)
- Complete all student information for #15.
- Have student sign and date the application. (A parent may sign if the student is in grades K-4.)
- Have Principal/Registrar complete and sign Part B. Your school principal/registrar should fill out Part B, unless the student does not yet attend an Adventist school. A pastor may fill out Part B **ONLY** if the student **HAS NOT** attended an SDA school.
- **College Students:** Part B of the Education Scholarship Application can be filled out by more than one person, if necessary. An academic advisor and a financial advisor may be in a position to know the answers. Please have anyone who fills out a portion sign their name.

Collect all required attachments and signatures in plenty of time to reach the **NU Office of Education before August 1.**

Please use one of the methods of delivery listed below. We cannot take responsibility for any application that is turned into your school or church office that does not reach the Office of Education. We will not accept incomplete applications.
